Two residents and/or fellows will be selected. The program will afford residents and fellows the unique opportunity to participate in the political process of organized medicine at the national level. Applicants must be members of the AMA. Each resident or fellow will receive a \$1,000 stipend to help defray program-related expenses (e.g., airfare, hotel, cabs); all other expenses are the responsibility of the resident or fellow. The selected resident or fellow is also responsible for securing his or her own housing accommodations.
