Follow-up on implementation prior to the 2009 Interim Meeting.
Resolution 2: Medical Student Loan Repayment	Adopted	RESOLVED, That our American Medical Association study the impact the new Higher Education Opportunity Act will have on the length of time it will take young physicians to pay off their medical student loans and the impact of early loan repayment on persons choosing careers in medicine, and on specialty selection by medical students. (Directive to Take Action).	Adopted by the HOD as Resolution 323. Follow-up on implementation prior to the 2009 Interim Meeting.
Late Resolution 1: Public Loan Forgiveness Program	Adopted as amended	RESOLVED, That our American Medical Association seek to ensure that all resident and fellow physicians <u>in training</u> fall within the definition of public service jobs for the purposes of the Public Service Loan Forgiveness Program, <del>regardless of employment status or employer type</del> (Directive to Take Action); and be it further  RESOLVED, that our American Medical Association seek to ensure that all physicians in active medical practice who accept either Medicare, <del>or Medicaid</del> <u>or Tricare</u> fall within the definition of public service jobs for the purposes of the Public Service Loan Forgiveness Program, <del>regardless of employment status or employer type.</del> (Directive to Take Action)	Referred by the HOD as Resolution 324. Follow-up on implementation prior to the 2010 Annual Meeting.
