American Medical Association Inks Deal With Compuware Covisint to Improve Physician Practice Efficiency

DETROIT and CHICAGO--April 22, 2009--Compuware Corporation (NASDAQ: CPWR) announced today that its Covisint subsidiary signed an agreement with the American Medical Association (AMA) to deploy an innovative health information exchange solution delivering value to its 240,000 member physicians and the physician population at large.
