



CPT® Category I Vaccine Codes

Code 90654 was accepted at the June 2010 CPT Editorial Panel meeting for the 2012 CPT book production cycle. This code is not included in the 2011 CPT codebook. However, due to the Category I vaccine product codes early release policy, this code was effective on January 1, 2011, following the six month implementation period which began July 1, 2010.

The FDA approval pending indicator (↗) was removed from code 90654 following notification of the achievement of FDA approval status for this product on May 10, 2011.

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The H1N1 vaccine product codes 90663 and administration code 90470 developed for the 2009 Swine Flu Pandemic are no longer valid codes for reporting current flu vaccines. This change became effective in October 2010 when the CPT Editorial Panel approved the request to delete these codes, although the codes appear in the print copy of CPT 2011.
