State-specific provisions of settlement

H_ § 7.9 Physician Advisory Committee
(o) With respect to the Blue Plan CareFirst, Inc., CareFirst Blue Cross Blue Shield DC, CareFirst Blue Cross Blue Shield Maryland, Inc. (hereinafter as used in this Exhibit H collectively “CareFirst”), § 7.9 is amended by replacing the phrase “state medical society” with the phrase state medical society and The Medical Society of Northern Virginia.
H_ § 7.11 Determinations Related to Medical Necessity
(c) CareFirst shall not be obligated to comply with the requirements of § 7.11 with respect to the Maryland state employee health benefits program.
H_ § 7.18 Timelines for Processing and Payment of Complete Claims
(b) CareFirst will not be required to follow § 7.18 for the Maryland state employee health benefits program.
H_ § 7.22 Overpayment Recovery Procedures
(b) CareFirst shall comply with the obligations under § 7.22 except with respect to the 18-month time limit for Overpayment recovery, which shall not apply to the Maryland state employee health benefits program.
