State-specific provisions of settlement

H_ § 7.9 Physician Advisory Committee
(q) The Blue Plan Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan, Inc. (hereinafter as used in this Exhibit H "BCBSMI") shall be permitted to continue its existing physician advisory committee activities and shall not be subject to the provisions of § 7.9 of the Agreement.
H __ §§ 7.8, 7.18, 7.19 & 7.20 Bundling and Claim Editing Systems (excluding Legacy Exceptions)
(a) BCBSMI is migrating its local claims system to its NASCO based system. BCBSMI will, upon becoming aware of a deficiency in its claim's system with respect to §§ 7.19 and 7.20 of the Agreement, cure the deficiency on a going forward basis so that the system complies with the § 7 standards.
H __ § 7.21 EOB and Remittance Advice
(a) BCBSMI shall comply with the requirements of § 7.21(a) of the Agreement except that BCBSMI need not provide a separate identification number as provided in clause (i) of § 7.21(a).
H __ § 7.30 Compliance with State Law and Applicable Government Contracts
(e) As long as BCBSMI's Medicare Advantage programs apply the federal rules for "deemed contract providers" in Michigan (which rules, in summary, permit all willing providers meeting CMS standards to receive direct payment for services to Medicare Advantage enrollees), BCBSMI's Medicare Advantage programs are excluded from the application of this Agreement.
H_ BCBSMI/Michigan Health Insurance Company
Michigan Health Insurance Company's membership is being folded into BCBSMI over the next months, and when that membership becomes part of BCBSMI, Covered Services provided by Physicians to this membership will then be subject to the Agreement. In addition, the parties agree that Class Members who had provider agreements with Michigan Health Insurance Company and BCBSMI may, for the purposes of § 8.3(c), aggregate gross receipts received from Michigan Health Insurance Company for Covered Services with the gross receipts received from BCBSMI for Covered Services for each of the years 2004, 2005, and 2006.
