

### Laboratory Testing (Calcium, Phosphorus, Intact Parathyroid Hormone (iPTH) and Lipid Profile)

#### Coding Specifications

Codes required to document patient has chronic kidney disease (CKD) and a visit occurred:

An ICD-9 diagnosis code for CKD and a CPT E/M service code are required to identify patients to be included in this measure.

#### CKD ICD-9 diagnosis codes

- 585.4, 585.5 (CKD, stage iv or v)

AND

#### CPT E/M service codes

- 99201, 99202, 99203, 99204, 99205 (office — new patient),
- 99212, 99213, 99214, 99215 (office — established patient),
- 99241, 99242, 99243, 99244, 99245 (outpatient consult)

Quality codes for this measure (one of the following for every eligible patient):

#### CPT II Code descriptors

(Data Collection sheet should be used to determine appropriate combination of codes.)

- **CPT II 3278F:** Serum levels of calcium, phosphorus, intact parathyroid hormone (iPTH) and lipid profile ordered
- **CPT II 3278F-1P:** Documentation of medical reason(s) for not ordering serum levels of calcium, phosphorus, intact parathyroid hormone (iPTH) and lipid profile
- **CPT II 3278F-2P:** Documentation of patient reason(s) for not ordering serum levels of calcium, phosphorus, intact parathyroid hormone (iPTH) and lipid profile
- **CPT II 3278F-8P:** Serum levels of calcium, phosphorus, intact parathyroid hormone (iPTH) and lipid profile not ordered, reason not otherwise specified

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
