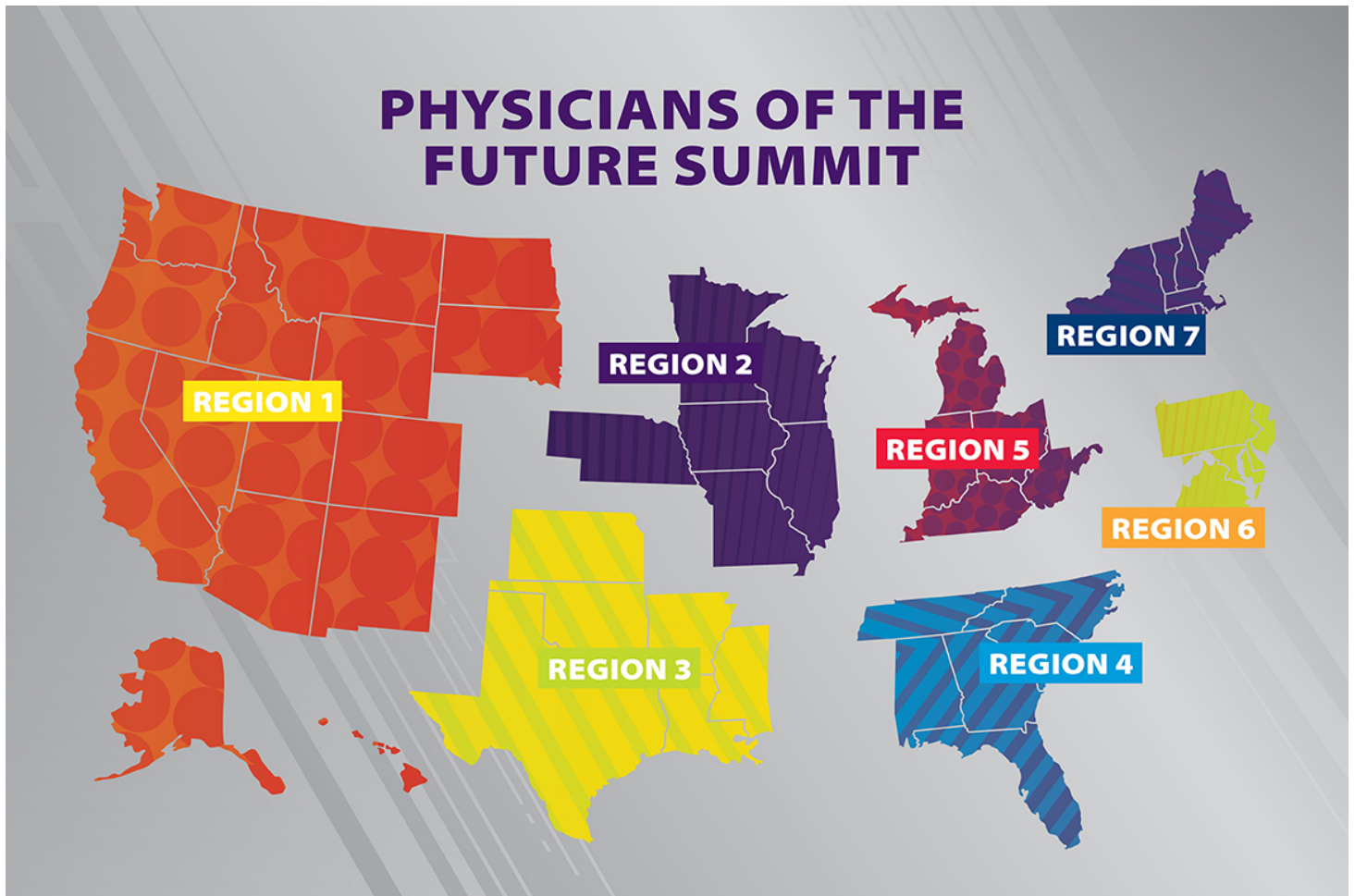


Physicians of the Future Summit
