Additional verbal comments on any issue can be provided in person at the Panel meeting following a statement of conflict of interest. The applicant(s) who submitted the original code change application is automatically considered an interested party and are notified by AMA staff of any request for review submitted by another party.

\*Interested party requests will not be processed until the interested party submits a signed confidentiality agreement and disclosure of interest form. Interested party requests will be processed within 5 days of receipt of the requested forms. Written comments for these requests are due within 10 days upon receipt of materials. However, based upon receipt of these materials the deadline for written comments may vary. Please follow the instructions in the correspondence provided by AMA staff. May 19, 2017 is the deadline to submit

written comments or requests for review of any non-pathology issues.
