Subject: Establishing a Professional Services Claims-Based Payment Enhancement

for Activities Associated with the COVID-19 Pandemic

Referred to: Reference Committee A

Whereas, Over the past many months, our members continue to work vigorously to manage, treat, and oversee the response to the COVID-19 public health emergency (PHE); and

Whereas, Despite waivers enacted by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services during the COVID-19 pandemic that have helped provide relief to clinicians during this time, there remains a significant need to recognize the enhanced, non-separately reimbursable work performed by physicians during the PHE; and

Whereas, Our AMA believes it is imperative that clinicians have the resources to confront the pandemic and, eventually, engage in a swift recovery post-PHE; and

Whereas, A long-term policy that ensures additional resources can be made quickly available when future epidemics arise will be crucial to improving our collective response to infectious disease outbreaks, but in the meantime, short term solutions are warranted to address needs in the current PHE; and

Whereas, The CARES Act Provider Relief Fund is intended to provide support for "health care related expenses or lost revenue attributable to the coronavirus," but not for the increased level of effort demanded by delivering care in this environment; and

Whereas, Several national specialty societies have worked cooperatively to establish a professional services claims-based payment enhancement proposal that would quickly channel resources to health care practitioners on the frontlines of the COVID-19 pandemic; therefore be it

RESOLVED, That our American Medical Association work with other interested parties to advocate for regulatory action on the part of the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services to implement a professional services claims-based payment enhancement to help recognize the enhanced, non-separately reimbursable work performed by physicians during the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency. (Directive to Take Action)
