



Call for Candidates for AMA Nomination for the ACCME Board of Directors

The AMA is soliciting AMA member candidates for nomination by the AMA Board of Trustees for a position on the Board of Directors of the **Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education** (ACCME BOD).

TERM

The term of this position is 3 years (no more than 6 years' service), from January 1, 2027, through December 31, 2029.

TIME REQUIREMENT

Meetings are held in Chicago. Meetings for 2027 and 2028 are:

- Board of Directors Meetings – Apr 1-2, 2027; Jul 22-23, 2027; Dec 2-3, 2027; Mar 23-24, 2028; Jul 20-21, 2028; and Nov 30-Dec 1, 2028.
- ARC Meetings – Feb 17-18, 2027; Jun 9-10, 2027; Oct 20-21, 2027; Feb 16-17, 2028; Jun 7-8, 2028; and Oct 18-19, 2028.

CRITERIA FOR AMA NOMINATION TO ACCME BOD

ACCME Requirements for this Opportunity

1. Knowledgeable, experienced, and active in the leadership, management, or governance of a health care or health education organization.
2. Not an employee or officer of an ACCME member organization.
3. Not an employee or member of an organization ineligible for accreditation with the ACCME system.

AMA Requirements

Each nominee recommended by the AMA must be a member of the AMA at the time of nomination. If appointed, he/she must maintain AMA member status throughout the term of appointment. 1. Completed electronic **Application for AMA Nomination for External Leadership Position – ACCME BOD** (MS Word document preferred). This document is included on the AMA [Medical Education Leadership Opportunities](#) Web page.
2. Current **abbreviated curriculum vitae** [not to exceed three (3) pages].
3. Current **full curriculum vitae** [not to exceed ten (10) pages].
4. *Optional*: Up to one letter of recommendation, addressed to the AMA. No more than one letter will be accepted. Note: If nominated, letters of recommendation may be included as part of the nominee materials sent to the requesting organization.
