10:20 a.m.	<p>Education session: "Career Threats in an RVU-Driven World" *</p> <p>Description: Join the AMA Academic Physicians Section for a live session on the challenges faced by physicians at various stages of their careers due to the overemphasis placed by employers on the production of clinical relative value units (RVUs). This issue affects early, mid, and late-career physicians, but senior physicians are particularly vulnerable to institutional cost-cutting efforts. Their administrative roles, teaching, and research may be undervalued and less remunerative compared to RVU production, which is favored by C-suite leadership who prioritize bottom-line thinking.
