3 Whereas, hybrid meetings with in-person and remote attendance have become the norm,  
4 including at the American Medical Association with the Women Physicians Section and the CPT  
5 Editorial Meetings having hybrid meetings; and

7 Whereas, the Private Practice Physicians Section has a diverse membership spread across  
8 multiple time zones and intersectionally wearing many hats with many competing needs, from  
9 family and personal needs and health issues to workplace crises that may preclude in-person  
10 participation in deliberations of the PPPS and voting for leaders to represent their interests;  
11 therefore be it

13 Resolved, that our Private Practice Physicians Section adopts hybrid meetings and hybrid  
14 voting beginning with the 2024 Interim Meeting (Directive to Take Action); and be it further

16 Resolved, that the Private Practice Physicians Section Internal Operating Procedures and other  
17 governing documents be amended to effect these changes (Directive to Take Action).
