Report of Committee on Rules and Credentials

1      Madam Speaker, Members of the House of Delegates:

3      Your Committee on Rules and Credentials recommends the following temporary rules for this  
4      meeting:

6      1. Standing Rules

7      The current edition of the "House of Delegates Reference Manual: Procedures, Policies  
8      and Practices" serves as our standing rules delineating the official method of procedure in  
9      handling and conducting the business before the AMA House of Delegates.

11     2. House Security

12     Maximum security shall be maintained at all times to prevent disruptions of the House, and  
13     only those individuals who have been properly badged will be permitted to attend.

14  
15     3. Credentials

16     The registration record of the Committee on Rules and Credentials shall constitute the  
17     official roll call for this meeting of the House.

18  
19     4. Order of Business

20     The order of business as published in the Handbook shall be the official order of business  
21     for all sessions of the House of Delegates. This may be varied by the Speaker if, in their  
22     judgment, it will expedite the business of the House, subject to any objection sustained by  
23     the House.

25     5. Privilege of the Floor

26     The Speaker may grant the privilege of the floor to such persons as may be presented by  
27     the President, or Chair of the Board of Trustees, or others who may expedite the business  
28     of the House, subject to objections sustained by the House.

29  
30     6. Limitation on Debate

31     There will be a 90 second limitation on debate per presentation subject to waiver by the  
32     Speaker for just cause.

34     7. Nominations and Elections

35     The House will receive nominations for President-Elect, Speaker, Vice Speaker, Trustees  
36     and Council Members during the Opening Session of the House of Delegates on Friday  
37     evening, June 6. Once nominations are closed there shall be no further nominations. All  
38     nominated candidates for any open or potentially open position will be included on the  
39     ballot unless they specifically ask for their name to be withdrawn from nomination. Officer  
40     candidates in contested elections will give speeches during the Opening Session of the  
41     House. The order of speeches will be selected by lottery.

1       The Association's 2025 annual election balloting shall be held Tuesday, June 10 from 8:00  
2       to 8:30 am during an Election Session. Only credentialed delegates will be allowed in the  
3       delegate seating area. Elections will be held sequentially with president-elect first, followed  
4       by other officers and then councils in alphabetical order.

5  
6       In instances where there is only one nominee for an office, a majority vote without ballot  
7       shall elect on Friday.

8       8. Conflict of Interest

9       Members of the House of Delegates who have an interest that is or may be material to the  
10      matter being considered and that would reasonably be expected to impair the objectivity of  
11      the individual who is testifying, must publicly disclose that interest immediately prior to  
12      testifying at a reference committee on the matter or speaking on the floor of the House of  
13      Delegates on the matter.

15       9. Conduct of Business by the House of Delegates

16       Each member of the House of Delegates and the AMA Officers resolutely affirm a  
17      commitment to abide by our AMA Code of Conduct.

18  
19       10. Respectful Behavior

20       Courteous, collegial, and respectful behavior in all interactions with others, including  
21      delegates, is expected of all attendees at House of Delegates meetings, including social  
22      events apart from House of Delegates meetings themselves.

26      we recommend its adoption.
