13 Delegates without clear protections in place to ensure that cuts in representation do not  
14 disproportionately affect medical students, residents, and fellows.

16 Your Rules Committee recommends Emergency Resolution 1 be considered for  
17 business. This topic is timely and urgent given the update given at the 2026 RFS Assembly  
18 Meeting earlier today from the RFS Councilor on Long Range Planning & Development  
19 about the upcoming 2026 AMA Interim Meeting report. This Council on Long Range  
20 Planning & Development update had been embargoed until today, justifying the  
21 emergency nature.
