Subject: Planning for the results of the Digital Health and AI Taskforce Report

Referred to: Reference Committee (Assigned by HOD)

1 Whereas, A-24 Resolution 606 "Creation of an AMA Council with a focus on digital health
2 technologies and AI" was defeated 60% to 40% in favor of a task force to study this issue; and
3

4 Whereas, a related AMA business unit, the Center for Digital Health and AI, was announced in
5 October 2025 that did not include a direct policy interface with the House of Delegates; and
6

7 Whereas, AMA policy statements and positions on AI and digital health have been announced
8 through this Center without review by an HOD Council, the House of Delegates, or the task
9 force on digital health and AI; and

11 Whereas, a preliminary report by the taskforce at A-25 failed to mention the benefits or
12 drawbacks for a Council or other advisory committee comprised of HOD members, instead
13 summarizing the current status of digital health and AI efforts by the AMA business unit; and

15 Whereas, an anticipated final task force report is expected by A-26 or I-26 with presumed
16 recommendations for how HOD policy input and guidance about digital health and AI might be
17 incorporated into the structure of the AMA; therefore be it
18

19 RESOLVED, that our American Medical Association create a robust advisory committee or
20 other HOD entity that promotes health policy input and guidance from the HOD on matters
21 related to digital health, AI, and their intersection with medical practice and education; and be it
22 further

24 RESOLVED, that our AMA ensure any advisory committee or other HOD entity focused on
25 digital health and AI be representative of the membership of the AMA.
