



Call for Candidates for AMA Nomination for the ACGME Board of Directors

The AMA is soliciting AMA member candidates for nomination by the AMA Board of Trustees for a position on the **Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education Board of Directors** (ACGME BOD).

TERM

The term of this position is 3 years, from September 27, 2026, to September 2029, with a maximum tenure of 2 terms.

TIME REQUIREMENT

The ACGME Board meets three times per year (February, June, and September/October). The duration of the meetings is 3 to 4 days. These meetings are typically held in Chicago at the ACGME headquarters.

CRITERIA FOR AMA NOMINATION TO ACGME BOD

ACGME Requirements for this Opportunity

- The ACGME is requesting nominees with IT/AI, legal, business, finance, and/or public policy experience.
- The ACGME would also welcome the nomination of people who are or have served in the capacity of CEO or in similar positions in health care organizations.
- Geographically, the ACGME is ideally seeking individuals from the Western US (other than California), North Central and Central areas of the U.S., with a particular interest in individuals with experience in rural settings.
- By specialty, hospital-based physicians and surgeons are particularly needed as well.

AMA Requirements

Each nominee recommended by the AMA must be a member of the AMA at the time of nomination. If appointed, he/she must maintain AMA member status throughout the term of appointment. TO APPLY FOR NOMINATION

To apply for nomination, complete and email the following documents to mary.grandau@ama-assn.org by **Friday, July 10, 2026**:

1. Completed electronic **Application for AMA Nomination for External Leadership Position – ACGME BOD** (MS Word document preferred). This document is included on the AMA [Medical Education Leadership Opportunities](#) Web page.
2. Current **abbreviated curriculum vitae** [not to exceed three (3) pages].
3. Current **full curriculum vitae**.
4. A separate **500-word biography from the candidate, required by the ACGME**.
5. *Optional*: One letter of recommendation, addressed to the AMA.

Note: If nominated, letters of recommendation may be included as part of the nominee materials sent to the requesting organization. The ACGME Governance Committee will conduct interviews of nominees as well.
