### Statement of interest

I am interested in serving for a second term as a Member-at-Large for the Women's Physicians Section. In the past two years, I participated in discussions about women's leadership roles in society and Mentoring sessions for the past two years.

I am the 139th President of Santa Clara County Medical Association, the largest medical association in Northern California. I created the February 2024 Summit on Artificial Intelligence and Health Care, featuring speakers from IBM, Google, and health-related startups. I currently serve on the national American Medical Women's Association (AMWA) executive board. In June 2022, I participated in a White House Public Policy Round Table about reproductive health, leading to the Dobbs vs. Jackson Supreme Court decision. In June 2023, I was in Washington, DC, to speak with the Biden and Harris Health Policy Team about women's health and artificial intelligence.

I have created several mobile apps; Eyequix is for stroke and traumatic brain injury, now released as a videogame in iOS. In addition, I work with the University of California Santa Cruz's Department of Computational Psychology on user interface and virtual reality. I have been involved in health disparities since 2010, when I created the Journal of Asian Health, now under the auspices of the Stanford Center of Asian Research and Education.

I would like to be part of the Women's Physicians Section, where I can address healthcare issues for and about women physicians and their female patients.
