I have extensive experience in representing and working for physicians in both organized medical societies at the state and national levels. I have administrative experience as a medical director, chief medical officer, and as a Board Director for an Independent Practice Association and a Physician Hospital Organization.

As a Senior Vice President at Vizient Inc. I worked closely with the AMA to incorporate both the AMA Steps forward program and physician resilience strategies into CMS's Transformation of Clinical Practice Initiative with the Vizient Practice Transformation Network.
