c) Improve medical school and residency/fellowship application services to allow applicants to comprehensively showcase the non-research domains that best align with their experiences and career goals.

Your Reference Committee agrees that this resolution is timely because updates to ERAS will remove the ability of applicants to list publications that are not peer reviewed. We believe the MSS should amend our pending transmittal to reflect updates based on AAMC's update this past month. AMA-MSS members hold a myriad of engagement and leadership roles in the AMA as well as other organizations. Residency/fellowship applications should allow applicants to accurately portray their engagement and leadership roles. Your Reference Committee recommends Late Resolution 001 be adopted.

RESOLVED, that our American Medical Association study and report back with recommendations on how our organization can maintain leadership in medical ethics education, including an investigation of more sustainable or alternative publishing models for the *AMA Journal of Ethics*; and be it further

RESOLVED, that our AMA-MSS immediately forward this resolution to the I-25 House of Delegates.

Your Reference Committee agrees that the resolution is timely and urgent given that the *AMA Journal of Ethics* is set to cease publication of new content after December 2025. We believe this resolution is important to continue the *AMA Journal of Ethics* and provide transparency on any changes. We agreed on deletion of the second and third resolve clauses to replace them with a broader ask to continue the work of the journal. Your Reference Committee recommends Late Resolution 002 be adopted as amended.
