Since the Annual Meeting in 2025, the WPS GC and its members have continued to remain active. We were able to fulfill our goals from last year of the 3 Cs (collaborations, connections, community). This year, while sustaining those efforts, our WPS aims for the 5 As ("straight As"): Action, Activism, Advancement, Advocacy, Achievement. Our governing council (GC) had the wonderful opportunity to participate in the AMA Section Leadership Retreat (SLR) in August 2025, where we networked and socialized with governing council members from all the other AMA sections (including YPS), as well as with AMA staff leaders and the Board of Trustees. Feedback can be anonymous for optimal candor. In addition, in honor of Women in Medicine month during September, the WPS sponsored a webinar "The Future is FemTech: Women Shaping Digital Health" and if you missed it, I recommend watching the recording. I was fortunate to serve as a moderator representing the WPS as the YPS Representative. The WPS House of Delegates (HOD) handbook review committees convene prior to each WPS meeting to review items of business under consideration by the HOD.
