The sponsor also wavered in their efforts to address the legal concerns, not submitting the resolution until Wednesday, thereby adding to the delay. Your Committee on Rules and Credentials is not persuaded that the legal issues could not have been resolved in a more timely fashion. Moreover, this is not a new concern for physicians and our AMA has considerable policy on this issue, which will allow advocacy on the matter even without this resolution. For these reasons, the Committee recommends that the resolution not be accepted. Mister Speaker, this concludes the Supplementary Report of the Committee on Rules and Credentials.
