



# Call for Candidates for AMA Nomination for the ACGME Review Committee for Psychiatry

The AMA is soliciting AMA member candidates for nomination by the AMA Board of Trustees for the **Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education Review Committee for Psychiatry (ACGME RC-PSYCH)**.

## **TERM**

The term of the position is 6 years, from July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2032.

## **TIME REQUIREMENT**

Nominees must be able to devote sufficient time to the Review Committee's work and attend all committee meetings. The Review Committee for Psychiatry typically meets twice per year. The duration of meetings is one-and-a-half days.

Nominees will need sufficient time to fulfill the responsibilities of the committee. This will include participation in 1) new program reviews and other non-accreditation reviews; 2) annual data review for all accredited programs; 3) subcommittee work (as assigned); 4) prep time for each Review Committee meeting to review agenda items (and related documents); and 5) actual travel to/attendance at each Review Committee meeting.

Anticipated dates for new members:

- Review Committee Meeting to observe – April 2026
- Two Review Committee Meetings per year – February and April

## **CRITERIA FOR AMA NOMINATION TO ACGME RC-PSYCH**

### **ACGME RC-PSYCH Requirements for this Opportunity**

1. Nominees must be board certified by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology (ABPN) with a background in education and expertise in graduate medical education.
2. Although a Review Committee can have up to two members from the same state, they cannot be from the same institution or city/metropolitan area. Accordingly, individuals should not be nominated from the following institutions and areas:

- University of California Irvine School of Medicine – Orange, CA
  - Yale School of Medicine – West Haven, CT
  - University of Kentucky – Lexington, KY
  - Cambridge Health Alliance/ Harvard Medical School – Cambridge, MA
  - UMass Chan Medical School – Worcester, MA
  - Central Michigan University Medical Education – Saginaw, MI
  - Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai – New York, NY
  - Northwell Health Staten Island University Hospital – State Island, NY
  - Northeast Ohio Medical University – Rootstown, OH
  - Phoenixville Hospital – Phoenixville, PA
  - University of Texas at Austin Dell Medical School – Austin, TX
  - University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center – Dallas, TX
  - University of Vermont Medical Center – Burlington, VT
  - West Virginia University School of Medicine – Morgantown, WV
3. Nominees must be skilled in the use of computers. Review Committee members must use electronic systems for reimbursement of expenses and accreditation activities, including program reviews.
  4. Nominees must be able to devote sufficient time to the Review Committee's work and attend all committee meetings. The Review Committee for Psychiatry typically meets twice per year. The duration of meetings is one-and-a-half days.
  5. Nominees will need sufficient time to fulfill the responsibilities of the committee. This will include participation in 1) new program reviews and other non-accreditation reviews; 2) annual data review for all accredited programs; 3) subcommittee work (as assigned); 4) prep time for each Review Committee meeting to review agenda items (and related documents); and 5) actual travel to/attendance at each Review Committee meeting.
  6. Nominees must have a minimum of five years of experience as a program director.
  7. Nominees must participate in major specialty societies or have current or past association with graduate medical education.
  8. Nominees' programs must have a status of Continued Accreditation.

### **AMA Requirements**

Each nominee recommended by the AMA must be a member of the AMA at the time of nomination. If appointed, he/she must maintain AMA member status throughout the term of appointment. 1. Completed electronic **Application for AMA Nomination for External Leadership Position – ACGME RC-PSYCH** (MS Word document preferred). This document is included on the AMA Medical Education Leadership Opportunities Web page.

2. Current **abbreviated curriculum vitae** [not to exceed three (3) pages].
3. Current **full curriculum vitae**.
4. *Optional*: One letter of recommendation addressed to the AMA. No more than one letter of recommendation will be accepted. Note that, if nominated, the letter of recommendation may be included as part of the nominee materials sent to the requesting organization.
